Detailed Progress

We regularly report on the target grades and current attainment for your child (approximately one assessment and report per half-term).

Target Grades

These are based on externally-set targets using a combination of national data and prior attainment of the individual students. The grades can be A*-G (legacy GCSEs) or 1-9 (new GCSEs).

Current Attainment

These grades reflect the regular assessments that teachers have used to assess progress during that half term and over the year as a whole.

You may find in the earlier stages of the course that the current grade may be some way off the target as it is purely based on key assessed areas of the course. As it is a cumulative result, based on assessments throughout the GCSE course, the current grade becomes a more reliable indicator of what your child is likely to achieve at the end of Year 11.
