Year 10

What will I learn?

There are a range of topics that you will study during Year 10

- Medicine and Britain, 1200-present
- Anglo-Saxon and Norman England, 1060-88
- Superpower Relations and the Cold War, 1941-91

These varied units will allow you to explore different time periods as well as different countries. They will enable you to develop your ability to explain why events happened in the past, how they changed and affected people's lives and how representations of the past have been constructed. You will interpret historical sources and you will start to think about their limitations to historians investigating the past.

How will I be assessed?

Throughout Year 10 you will be given regular assessments. They will range from content tests to more formal GCSE practice questions. Students will be provided with written feedback from their teacher following each written assessment.

How will I be taught?

You will be taught in a similar way to KS3 History. There will be a variety of different teaching and learning methods, such as presentations, role-play and group discussion.
