GCSE Business Studies OCR - Year 11

What will I learn?

In GCSE Business Studies (OCR Specification), assessment is split into two exams that are sat at the end of Year 11. This course is assessed 100% by examinations which includes 7 units of study; Business activity, Marketing, People, Operations, Finance, Influences on Business and The Interdependent Nature of Business. There is only one tier of entry.

How will I be assessed?

Throughout Year 11, you will complete an end of unit test on average every 6 weeks. These will take place in lesson time under exam conditions to build your confidence and skills ready for your exams at the of the year. You will complete two full mocks during year 11 – J204/02 in January and J204/01 after Easter.

How will I be taught?

There will be opportunities to attend business presentations and workshops from a variety of business organisations, which will give you a practical view of your studies. You will study a range of local/national businesses, examining current business problems and identifying relevant solutions. You will use ICT to research firms, write reports and prepare presentations on your business solutions. You will get the opportunity to visit real businesses and apply this knowledge to your studies.
