## Our Classroom Expectations

### Start of lessons:

- ◆ Quietly enter the room with your teacher's permission
- ◆ Sit where requested by the teacher
- ◆ Place your planner and equipment for the session on the desk, your bag on the floor, and take off your coat
- ◆ Be ready to take part, to learn, and to demonstrate your skills and understanding
- ◆ Remain silent whilst the register is taken

### During lessons:

- ◆ Listen actively. Be polite. Play a positive part in the lesson
- ◆ With your teacher's permission you may bring water to class (no other drinks), provided there is not a health and safety risk
- ◆ You must not have a mobile phone out in the lesson, unless your teacher requests this and then uses the front-of-classroom phone sign
- ◆ Use break and lunchtimes to use the toilet. If you do need to be excused during a lesson, ask your teacher to initial the passport page in your planner. You won't be allowed to leave a lesson to fill a water bottle. Do this during break and lunchtime

### End of lessons:

- ◆ You will be asked to review and reflect on what you have learned
- ◆ Note down homework instructions in your planner or write in 'None set'
- ◆ Pack away when asked to by your teacher
- ◆ Stand in silence behind your desk ready to be dismissed by your teacher
- ◆ Leave the room neat and tidy
- ◆ To assist our cleaning team, you will normally be asked to put chairs on desks at the end of the day
