Year 9 Careers Activity

For the next two weeks students in Year 9 will be completing the Future Skills Questionnaire (FSQ). The FSQ is a set of questions that have been specifically designed for young people in schools and colleges to help them to think about their skills, strengths and what they might like to do in the future. FSQ is a key feature of our school's careers programme created by the Careers and Enterprise Company (CEC). We will analyse learner responses to help evaluate our careers provision, plan future careers activities and also identify learners who may need additional support. The CEC will also use student responses to help improve careers provision for young people across the country There are up to three sections of the questionnaire that cover the following areas:

- Careers knowledge and skills
- Essential skills for life and work
- Career planning

Completing FSQ should be an engaging and insightful activity for students that will encourage them to continue thinking about their future choices and next steps after school or college. The FSQ is completed online, through a digital product called Compass+. All student data is processed in compliance with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The CEC will only see their responses, no names, for legitimate research and reporting purposes. The CEC will not be able to identify learners from their responses.
