What will I learn?

You will learn the skills needed to manage a business organisation, from methods of production, to ensuring quality. You will investigate the impacts of globalisation on business, including ethics and the effect on the environment.

Managing money is vital to every business and you will learn how to control the flow of cash into and out of the business and how to keep accounts. Firms are often affected by unexpected changes in demand, taxes, rising prices and even events abroad and you will learn how businesses cope with these situations. You will further your knowledge on the European Union and how the Euro affects imports and exports.

How will I be assessed?

Throughout Year 11, you will complete an end of unit test on average every 6 weeks. These will take place in lesson time under exam conditions to build your confidence and skills ready for your exams at the end of the year. You will complete 2 full mocks during year 11. One in January on A292 and the other after Easter on A293.

How will I be taught?

You will complete research tasks using the computers within the classroom. You will carry out independent reading to widen your knowledge of the business market. Your teacher will introduce you to new knowledge and concepts through some board work and working in groups to explore ideas.
