ENTRÉES



- Knowledge Organiser – practise key vocabulary using Look, Cover, Write, Check.

KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER:

The Knowledge Organiser is a summary of the key vocabulary we hope that you will recognise already. This is the vocabulary we'd like you to practise before you start at King Edwards. However, don't worry if you don't know everything, this page will also be in your Year 7 Knowledge Organiser, to refer to anytime! Use the Knowledge Organiser to check what you already know, as well as to revise, using techniques like Look, Cover, Write, Check, making some flashcards or a game. You can also use it to help with the various **plats principaux** tasks.

QUIZLET:

Quizlet is a fantastic app for learning and revising key vocabulary.

To use Quizlet, first you will need to set up an account. Go to: <https://quizlet.com/en-gb> And click on the **sign up** button on the top right-hand side.

Make sure your username has your name in it, so we know who you are! EG: if your name is Bob Smith, then a good user name would be: bobsmith123 or BobSmith_05 etc.

Once you have made an account, you need to join our YEAR 6 group. To do this follow the link here: <https://quizlet.com/join/xejCk8c2e>

There are 9 vocabulary sets here, which cover all the basics we would like you to know. For your **entrée**, try to work on at least one of these sets.

The YEAR 6 MEGA SET is a combination of all topics and is one of your **dessert** options!

Use the flashcards to learn the words and then practise using Match, Gravity or any of the other options!

LINGUASCOPE:

Linguascope is another great way to learn and practise vocabulary.

This time the log-in details are the same for everyone.

Go to: <https://www.linguascope.com/> Then log in using these details:

USERNAME: kingedmf1

You can use Linguascope to learn any vocabulary you wish; you could even try a different language! However, your **entrée** options are these 7 sets. Go to **Beginner - French** and then choose:

- **LES BASES** : les couleurs, les nombres, les dizaines
- **MOI ET MA FAMILLE** : mes animaux, les membres de ma famille
- **MON ENVIRONNEMENT** : la météo
- **LA VIE AU QUOTIDIEN** : dans ma trousse
