Admissions – Frequently asked questions

What are our admissions criteria?

Children who have an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan which names the school must by law be offered a place at that school.

- 1) Children in care (looked after children) and children who were previously in care
- 2) Sibling: where the child has a sibling in the school or a sibling has already been offered a place at the school, and where the sibling will still be attending the school at the time of admission.
- 3) Children who are ordinarily resident in the catchment area.
- Children who live outside the school's catchment area.

Can I apply online?

You apply by logging onto the Citizen Portal at www.suffolk.gov.uk

Do I need to choose three schools?

We recommend that you choose three schools. Your application will be considered in order of your preferred choices.

What is the closing date for applications?

Applications must be received by Suffolk County Council by 31 October 2024.

When will I know if my child has been offered a place?

If you apply online, an email will be sent on Monday 3 March 2025. If you make a paper application, a letter will be sent on 3 March 2025.

Will there be a waiting list?

Suffolk County Council will hold a waiting list 31 December 2025. This list is subject to change.
