
Easter Island

It's located an incredible 2182 miles from the mainland in Chile. 1289 miles away from the remote Pitcairn islands (which are its closest neighbours), it is one of the most inhabited isolated islands on Earth. Because of this, I have met loads of people and I am dreading when I'll have to leave! I flew into its international airport from Santiago in Chile - which has daily flights to Easter Island. It's funny to think that it's one of the remotest places on the planet: my tour guide said that tens of thousands of people visit every year and that it is one of the most popular isolated places in the world! I would actually love to live here: it has shops and schools and 7750 people live here permanently. I loved seeing the beautiful stone statues called Moai - that cover the island. There are almost 1,000 of them!
