# **IMPORTANT Covid Precautions and Information**

We will be distributing more lateral flow home test kits to all students next week during tutor time.

More information can be found in the <u>letter sent</u> to parents last week.

Although the wearing of face coverings is optional for the time being there may be occasions during the school day when they are required for a number of reasons. Please ensure your child has a mask in their bag just in case.

We have had a number of positive LFD and PCR tests within our student community this week. As there is no longer a requirement to self-isolate, it is even more important that regular LFD testing takes place twice weekly (unless advised by track and trace to test daily). However, this test is only effective if your child is **completely symptom free**. If your child is feeling unwell at all and in particular feeling sick, a tummy ache, a slight cough or slight sore throat please arrange for a PCR Test. This is a FREE test that you have to await the result. Please keep your child off school until this result comes back negative.

Please continue to test twice weekly. It is essential that ALL results (LFD and PCR) are reported to us <u>via our website</u> and to <u>NHS test</u> and trace.

There is a new FREE walk-in PCR testing centre at Olding Road in Bury. Booking is advised and can be done online or by called 119. Opening hours are 8am-8pm daily. More information can be found on the Council website.
