Level 1	At KS3 students in Mathematics will have 12 mini assessments throughout the year. Year 7 Assessments 7 to 12 in Mathematics covers the content covered between February and July. Students should ensure they bring their maths equipment, which includes pen, pencil, ruler, protractor, pair of compasses and calculator.

Level 3	 Add and subtract fractions Find a fraction of an amount Simplify algebraic expressions Solve equations
