Level 1	<p>At KS3 students in Mathematics will have 12 mini assessments throughout the year.</p> <p>Year 8 Assessments 1 to 6 in Mathematics covers the content covered between September and February. Students should ensure they bring their maths equipment, which includes pen, pencil, ruler, protractor, pair of compasses and calculator.</p>
