

- Hunger Games series by Suzanne Collins.
- Divergent series by Veronica Roth. These books cover quite a few 'genres' and ideas – a must read.
- *Maze Runner* series by James Dashner.
- The Host by Stephanie Meyer.
- Uglies series by Scott Westerfield.
- Ender's Game ('Ender's Saga' Book 1) by Orson Scott Card. Andrew "Ender"
  Wiggin thinks he is playing computer simulated war games; he is, in fact, engaged in something far more desperate.
- The 5th Wave ('The 5th Wave' Series Book 1) by Rick Yancey. After the 1st wave, only darkness remains. After the 2nd, only the lucky escape. And after the 3rd, only the unlucky survive. After the 4th wave, only one rule applies: trust no one.
- Matched by Alli Conde. A society where every aspect of your life is state controlled even who you fall in love with.
