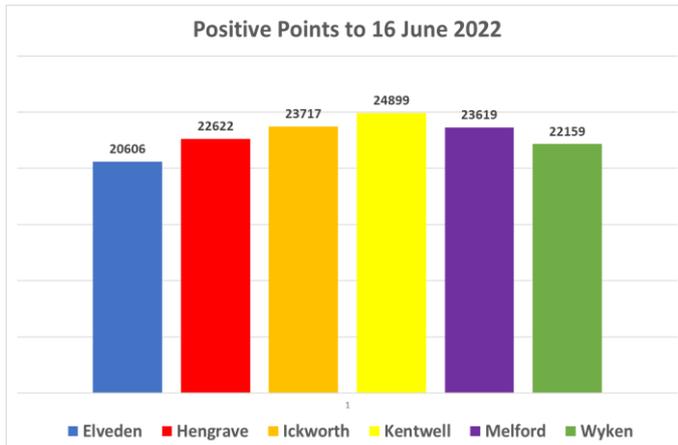

Year 8 and 10 teams have again been taking part in the F1 in Schools competition. They have been trialling their F1 cars on the official track in advance of the Regional Finals. Team leaders Theo Williams, Lotte Howes, Rhys Langton and Fynn Greenin went to Thurston Community College to race their prototypes with The Vipers (Rhys Langton's team) being the winners on the day.



Since January, the teams have been designing and manufacturing their cars using CAD software and CNC machinery. They have to create a team identity, a design portfolio, a pit display and give a verbal presentation to judges alongside their final car design. It's been a busy year for the teams!

DofE Bronze Expedition

Year 9 students took part in a very successful expedition from Thetford to Brandon at the weekend. They walked approximately 12 miles altogether and were lucky with the weather. Fantastic efforts on behalf of everyone involved!

Alternatively, please don't hesitate to contact your child's Pastoral Support Manager for additional support.

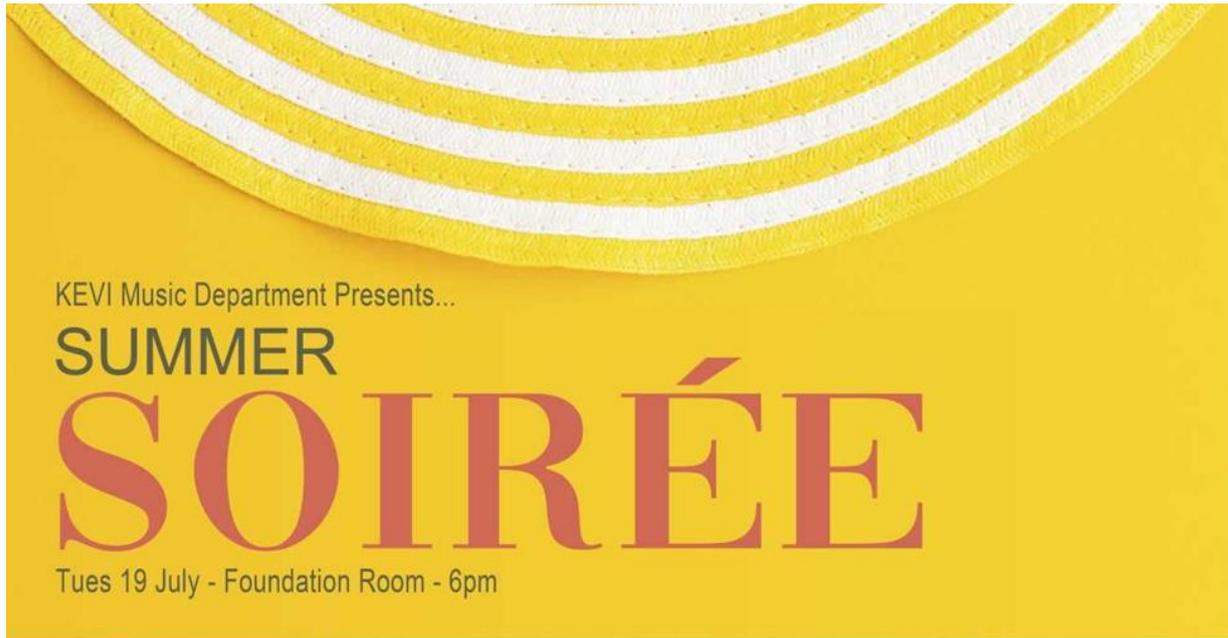
Online Safety - Discord App Security Settings

During and post-lockdown the app Discord has become hugely popular with young people. Historical usage was related to gaming, where young people would play online games together and discuss the game within the Discord app. However, it is now being used as a messaging system similar in many ways to WhatsApp.

Discord requires users be over the age of 13 to create accounts, however this relies on honesty and is up to users and family members to ensure correct information is given. As with many apps there is no age verification and there is lots of 18+ content, including children setting up their own servers (chat rooms) and allowing anyone to enter. The safety features within Discord are unsurprisingly limited but there are some you can view [HERE](#) for your own knowledge.
