Go4Schools - NEW Parent and Student site

Your child's page is constantly updated, providing you with the latest information. Go4Schools will have a new look and layout in September 2022. This guide is intended to inform you of the changes and remind you what Go4Schools can do.

Using Go4Schools, you will be able to view your child's progress online and access the following information at any time:

- Real-time assessment information marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
- Attendance Shown from the start of the academic year
- Timetable Your child's daily and weekly timetable
- Progress Reports Full written reports which are published three times a year
- Behaviour information

As before, you can access the site by going to <u>www.go4schools.com</u> and click on the Parents icon at the top of the main page to arrive at the log-in screen. The email address you use to enter the site must be the one we have registered in our database for you.

New users will need to request a password for Go4Schools. You can do this by entering your email address into the First-time User field and clicking 'Please send me a password'. A randomised password will then be generated and sent to your email address. You will then be able to log into the site and view your child's page.
