Reminders:


- Natural coloured hair only with no tramlines or other extreme haircuts
- Jewellery should not be worn except for one small stud in each ear and one discrete metal chain that can be worn under a shirt or jumper
- Rings and bracelets are strictly forbidden
- Nails should be cut to a safe length and there should be no nail polish
- Plain black school shoes only, no trainers
- No WHITE socks over BLACK tights. Black with black, please
- Skirts must be worn to their full length (not rolled up)
- Shirts should be tucked in at all times

Thank you to everyone who has prioritised and supported our high uniform standards. It makes such a difference to the school community when we do not need to challenge students on their uniform.
