Dear Parents and Carers

Industrial Action

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action, which will take place on Wednesday 1 February 2023, Wednesday 15 March 2023 and Thursday 16 March 2023. A further strike for the Eastern Region is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 1 March 2023. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teacher's pay and not because of any issues at our school.

We would like to give you as much notice as possible that learning may be disrupted on these dates. We are considering several options, in line with guidance, and will confirm our plans as soon as we can.

I am sorry about the potential disruption to you and to your child's education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect. King Edward VI School remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students and delivering high-quality teaching.

We are working closely with our staff, and I will inform you of the final arrangements as soon as possible via email. The information will also be on the school website.
