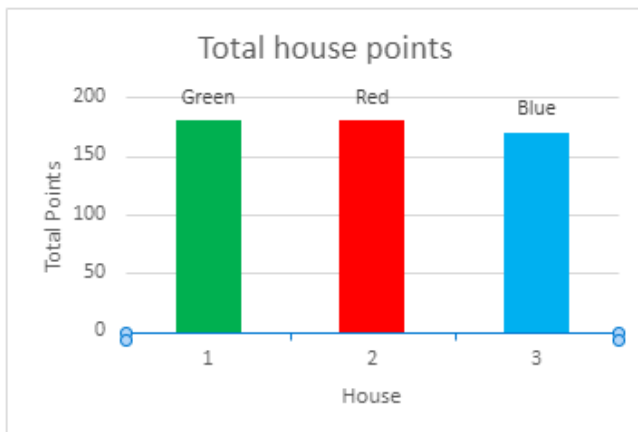

As a result of the Covid pandemic there are many young people who have missed out on important vaccinations. The Suffolk Community and School Age Immunisation Team is working very hard to clear this backlog. This includes HPV vaccinations (both doses) which are offered in Year 8 and Meningitis ACWY, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio which are offered in Year 9. As well as our school-based sessions we also offer community-based clinics.

They will be in Bury on Tuesday 4 April & Tuesday 11 April 2023, at the New Bury Community Clinic, 1 Charles Place, Bury St Edmunds, IP32 6TD for booked appointments only.
