


Vaccinations

Message from our Safeguarding Team

The 10 September 2023 was World Suicide Prevention Day, in line with this we would like you to take time with your child to watch the following one-minute clip from Papyrus and discuss its important message. <u>https://youtu.be/hrrhP68fYJ0</u>

Online bullying is a contributing factor for many young people having thoughts of suicide and over 200 schoolchildren die by suicide every year in the UK. We need everyone to be aware of the impact that online bullying can have on children and young people's mental health.

Bullying affects young people in many different ways. It can impact on their self-esteem, emotional wellbeing, education and life outside of school. Those experiencing bullying may feel self-conscious, embarrassed, or feel that they aren't 'worth' help. They may feel scared, sad or overwhelmed, and find it difficult to sleep or eat. Many young people who have been bullied find it really hard to ever feel safe or confident in anything they do, leading them to isolate themselves from others and give up the things they enjoy doing.
