

Why Should I go to my Learning Disability Annual Health Check when I turn 14?

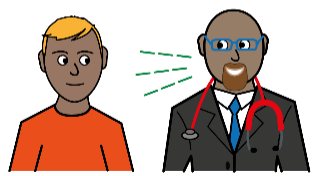
WHY?

- An annual health check helps find problems earlier and gets you the right help and treatment, you need to have good health

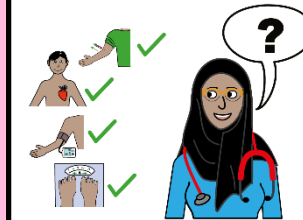
talk to your doctor

What is it ?

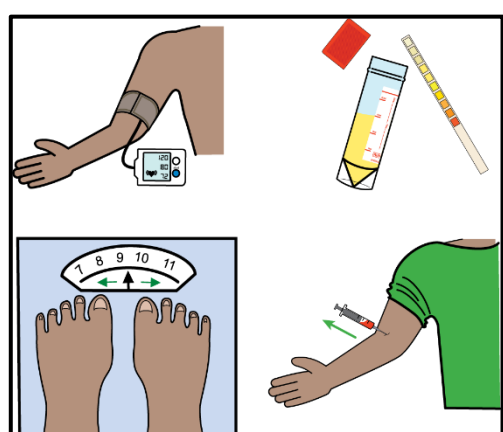
annual health check



- An Annual health check is an appointment at your doctors **once a year**
- These appointments start when you are **14**.
- If you feel well, It's still important to go to your annual health check
- You can go on your own or take someone you trust.

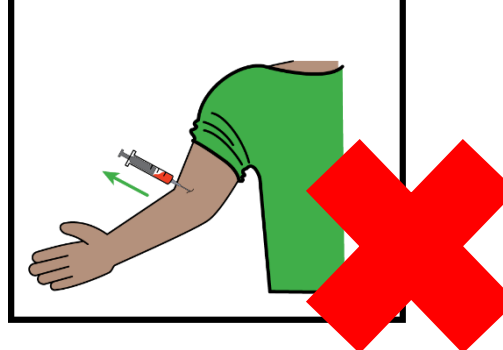
What checks happen at your annual health check?

At your appointment they will check your...



- Blood pressure
- Height
- Weight
- Pee
- Ears
- and Listen to your heart

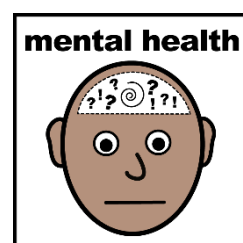

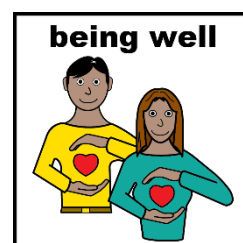
They may check some other things too. If you don't like blood tests you don't have to have one just say **no**.

What else?

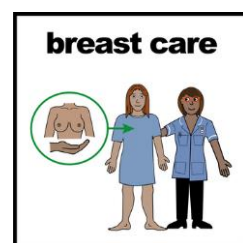
Your annual health check can help with other things like...



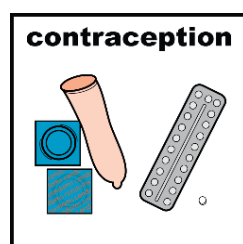
- Help with your mental health



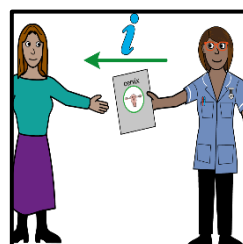
- Lifestyle advice ,for example healthy eating
