

Internet Safety Day - 6 February 2024

This week in extended tutor time, Key Stage 3 students explored Internet Safety, looking at the positive and negative impacts of online technologies; reflecting on their own personal

use and how they can demonstrate a positive online influence.

Year 8 continued exploring the theme by looking at the impact of social media on body image and how images can be manipulated, setting out unrealistic expectations of how teenagers should appear online, and the affects it can have on mental well-being.
