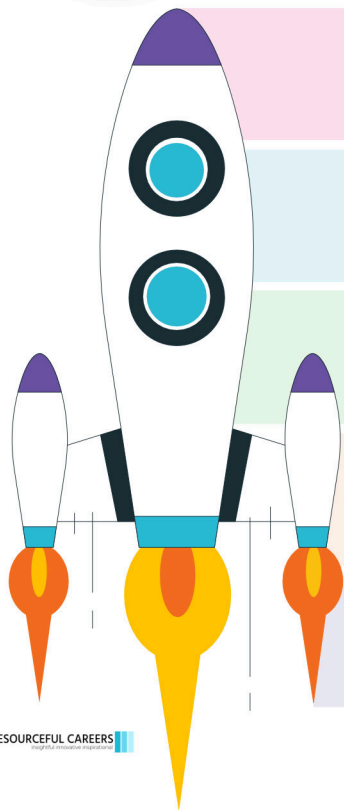

Collects numbers and statistics to identify trends, create models and present results.

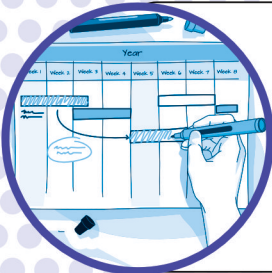
