


**Dear Parents and Carers**

The cost is £2.50 for the BBQ and £1.20 for the pizza.

Students should buy tickets in advance from Student Services. Upon buying their ticket, the cost will be deducted from their cashless catering account. Please ensure that there are sufficient funds in their account to cover this on the day of purchase.

Students who have a Free School Meal will be

able to have both BBQ at lunchtime and pizza at break, but they must collect a ticket from Student Services before the day. Refunds will only be given due to illness on the day. It is the students' responsibility to look after their ticket and produce it on the day of the event.

#### **Snapchat Updated Safety Features**

At the end of June, Snapchat updated the app with further safety features, including updates to account blocking functionality and enhanced friending safeguards.

- Block new friend requests sent from bad actors who were already blocked by the user, but sent from a different account from the same device.
- More frequent reminders about which friends they share their location with on Snap Maps.
- Further pop-up warnings if users add a friend who doesn't share mutual friends or is not a part of their contacts.
