

### GCSE Geography Fieldwork 2025

On Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 June, 104 GCSE Geography students deployed out to Walton-on-the-Naze and Cambridge town centre to complete their GCSE fieldwork. The intrepid students were required to investigate the sound scape within Cambridge, whereas the students at Walton-on-the-Naze beach were required to investigate the effectiveness of sea defences at protecting the coastline. Tuesday saw the students battling strong winds at the beach which required some individual problem solving when using tape measures and paper workbooks in the strong wind conditions!





The students in Cambridge worked very well in navigating as a team to completing independent work by measuring sound levels to see if they are above the World Health Organisation recommended levels. Thank you to all the staff who supported the successful delivery of both days.


**BOOK NOW: Long Road Open Evenings**
