
Flu Vaccinations

Shanghai 2025




Spaces are still available for the Home Visit with evening meal

Teen Chill

Teen Chill is a project whereby Abbeycroft has been funded by Bury Town Council, Suffolk Police Crime Commissioners and West Suffolk Council to provide young people with a safe environment to socialise on Monday evenings. 'Teen Chill' provides a service for young people in Bury St. Edmunds and immediate surrounding areas. Sessions are not structured, instead they allow young people to choose what you want to do...or do nothing. But if your child does want to get involved, there's plenty to do and they can suggest activities that they would like to see added.
