### Let's Talk About Anxiety: Parent and Carer Guidance

Anxiety is a natural response to everyday difficulties. It's normal for children and young people to feel anxious about certain things – just as it's normal for parents and carers to worry about their children. Most children and young people who are experiencing anxiety don't require specialist help. A good deal of what parents and carers already do can be helpful.

Normalising anxiety, helping your child to understand their own anxious feelings, and providing support and encouragement can make a big difference.

However, parents and carers, don't always know if their child is anxious and how they can support them, or what to do if their child's anxiety doesn't get better.

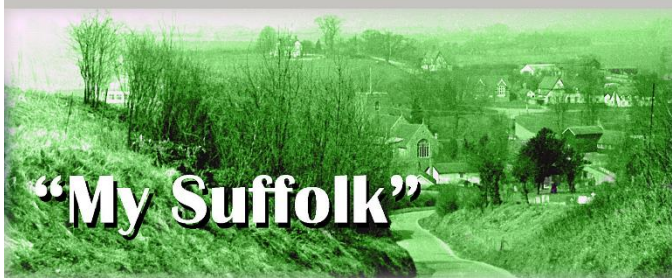
